Permitted calibers for hunting big game:

- a caliber with a minimum projectile diameter of 6 mm and a minimum kinetic energy of 1200 joules per 100 meters is permitted for Roe deer hunting.
- a caliber with a minimum projectile diameter of 7 mm and a minimum kinetic energy of 2500 joules per 100 meters is permitted for hunting White-tailed deer and Finnish forest Reindeer.
- > a caliber with a minimum projectile diameter of 7,62 mm and a minimum kinetic energy of 2500 joule; per 100 meters is allowed for hunting on the Moose.
