Permitted calibers for hunting big game:

- a caliber with a minimum projectile diameter of 6 mm and a minimum kinetic energy of 1200 joules per 100 meters is permitted for Roe deer hunting.
- a caliber with a minimum projectile diameter of 7 mm and a minimum kinetic energy of 2500 joules per 100 meters is permitted for hunting Red deer, Fallow deer, Mouflon, Chamois and Wild boar.
- a caliber with a minimum projectile diameter of 7.62 mm and a minimum kinetic energy of 2500 joules per 100 meters is allowed for hunting on the Red deer, Fallow deer, Mouflons and Wild boar in the Rut.
