1. Objectives and participants of the meeting

The participants came to Naples, Italy, on the 3rd October 2021 and the activities started the following day, 4th October 2021. During the long-term teaching training meeting, teachers took part in a coordinators' meeting, a local travel agency presentation about all the features of Recreational Tourism, a Slovak presentation on Topographic Preparation, two workshops and four excursions, all related to the main topic of the project: Recreational Tourism and UNESCO heritage sites.

This was the second mobility in our project, the first one after the pandemic, once at school, the welcome ceremony started, it included a welcome speech by the headmaster, a short description of the project and the delivery of some objects to the delegations such as a rucksack, a cap and a t-shirt imprinting the logo and the name of the project.

The ceremony has been a moment of deep emotion after the pandemic and has meant a new start of life and of normality in safety. All the subjects included have shown the will and the feeling to reconquer their freedom and sociality. At 11 a.m. the seminar of the Slovak coordinator about the topic of the mobility "Topographic Preparation" has taken place, it has been both educational and fun, as it was also interactive.

Workshops for students about the topographic preparation were held in two school labs.. All the students were divided in international groups and prepared 5 different itineraries about all the countries involved in the projects including at least two Unesco sites. The itineraries had to be presented in ppt or google presentations form by the students on Wednesday.

The 5th October 2021 was an excursion day, where we went on a tour of the touristic city of Sorrento. Unfortunately because of the bad weather the excursion to the Vesuvius has been substituted by a guided tour of Sorrento. Sorrento is one of Italy's most famous resort towns. Placed on a perch high above the Mediterranean, it is like a balcony over the sea with views. After a free lunch the group has joined the first Unesco site in the programme: the visit of the archeological site in Pompeii. **Pompeii** is an archaeological site near Naples, southern Italy, featuring the ruins of an ancient Roman town destroyed in 79 AD by the eruption of *Mount Vesuvius*; it is one of the world's most visited archaeological sites, 35 percent of the town, about 500 buildings, is currently open to the public. Yet, what makes Pompeii exceptional is not its extension, but its unique character of being an ancient town "frozen in time".

On The 6th October teachers and students arrived at school , the students and some of the teachers took part in the Travel Agency seminar about “Recreational Tourism” while the coordinators joined the coordinators’ meeting to take decisions about the ongoing status of the project and the dates for the upcoming mobilities. Meanwhile the students have presented their work about recreational tourism in their own countries and later the international groups have presented the outputs of the Monday workshop.

In the afternoon there was a planned visit of the Archeological museum of Naples where all the participants could have a complete vision of Pompei findings. .A visit to the museum is best paired with a tour of the archaeological sites of **Pompeii and Herculaneum**, as well as a hike up to the volcanic crater of Mt. Vesuvius.

The 7th October , excursion day was focused on Naples city centre, a guided tour of Naples old town , the 2nd archeological site foreseen by the project guidelines.

As part of the educational impact of the project the students have introduced some places of interest to their mates and teachers. The most appreciated places have been Decumani, San Gregorio Armeno, Ovo Castle. San Gregorio Armeno is definitely worth experiencing. Lined with a string of artisan workshops that make statuettes and scenery for traditional Neapolitan nativity scenes or presepi.

After a quick bite at 3 p. m. the group joined a guided tour of the San Carlo Theatre in Naples , the oldest opera house in Europe but unfortunately the supposed rehearsals of the Bohème could not be attended following the decisions of the artistic director of the play.

Highlight of the week has been the last day of activities the 8th October, at Sohara Luxury Club in Varcaturu.

That was a perfect location for a day packed with many activities and recreational moments. The day started with the organization of sports tournaments for students (beach volley, beach soccer, table tennis) supervised and guided by two fitness instructors while teachers could enjoy socializing activities , sunbathing ‘or listening to live music. Before lunchtime there was the handing of certificates from our headmaster to the foreign partners, a very moving moment which gave meaning to the mobility itself. All the teachers felt satisfied and proud because they could sense that the objectives of such experiences had met and even overcome: we all felt part of a community of interests and special bondings.

The lunch offered by the Italian school was a special moment of relaxation and conviviality followed by extra leisure activities at the beach.

3. MINUTES from the coordinators' meeting

1. Ms Ladňáková welcomed all the members of the team and started the meeting. She reminded that every country is supposed to prepare one day trip for the group of 25 people who are disadvantaged - it could be disadvantaged students or seniors and the students have to prepare itinerary for this trip and they have to plan the journey, the date and the time, km. The template is available on google drive. The deadline is till the end of December.
2. Miss Ladňáková will prepare a mobility tool of this Italian mobility with the whole description and the task for every member of TRIP team is to put their participants into this platform.
3. Another obligatory thing is dissemination. So on Google Drive every country has to upload all the material such as photos, videos descriptions of seminars and more about our trip mobility.
4. A guide of UNESCO heritage from Turkey has to be done till the next mobility in Lithuania. In this guide there should be about four monuments and approximately five lines to each of the monuments in Turkish language but also in English. The guide of UNESCO heritage from Italy has to be done as well by the Italian partner till 30th of November 2021. The guide of UNESCO heritage should be uploaded into Google Drive and all the countries have to translate it into their national languages till end of the year 2021.
5. Handbook for tourist guide is at the moment in the process and it will be done by the end of the year so till the end of December and the first two chapters will be prepared by Slovak team.
6. Dictionary is prepared on Google Drive and every country has to translate those terms into their own languages.
7. Itinerary has to be prepared for each single mobility so Turkey and Italy both have to prepare itineraries and have to upload them and they should not forget to put kilometres in.
8. Video from Italian mobility should be prepared before the Lithuanian mobility so Maria needs to upload this video into YouTube channel for TRIP. Italy also needs to upload all the presentations of students, all the videos and photos into Google Drive output - presentation (format PDF) and this is the task for all other countries as well!
9. Lesson plan about Italian UNESCO heritage has to be done and implemented into school curriculums until Lithuanian mobility.
10. As far as Turkish team is not presenting, they have to prepare a video on topographic preparation and upload it on google drive.
11. The main dissemination event will be a mini fair - one per each country so right now every country should be thinking about how to prepare this mini fair, how to manage it, who will

be involved (tourism organisation...?)

12. All the partners agreed on the following dates of mobilities: Lithuania 21st of November till 27th of November, Spain 6th of February till the 12th of February, Poland from 20th of March till the 26th of March and Slovakia from 2nd of May till the 8th of May.
13. For the next mobility in Lithuania all the participating students have to prepare a presentation about sport and adventure tourism in their own countries.
14. Miss Ladňaková as the coordinator is going to prepare a Word document with all the things that should be involved in the programme for Lithuanian mobility.
15. Lithuanian team should contact a travel agency about giving a presentation or lecture on sport and adventure tourism with at least two UNESCO heritage sites. The travel agency will present this to all the participating countries and the Lithuanian team should also prepare a video about their UNESCO heritage. The lecture and workshop in Lithuania will be provided by the coordinator-Miss Ladňaková.
16. Italian team is responsible to write a report after mobility in Italy.
17. During the discussion we were talking about Turkish team and that they need to find out from their national agency how to manage the budget because their students weren't travelling. But because they were online, Corina needs to mark down those who were online.
