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# 1 OBJECTIVES AND PARTICIPANTS OF THE MEETING

The participants arrived to Silale, Lithuania on the 21<sup>st</sup> November 2021 and the activities started the following day, 22<sup>nd</sup> November 2021. In general 20 students and 9 teachers from partners' countries (Turkey, Slovakia, Poland, Spain and Italy) attended the 3<sup>rd</sup> L/T/T in Lithuania. Also 18 students and 1 teacher from the local school participated in the project meeting. The list of participants is included in this document, as well.

The first day of the mobility, the 22<sup>nd</sup> November 2021, started with the opening ceremony. A short dance performance „The Witches of the Mounds“ was performed as a lot of activities were connected with visiting the mounds in the region and around the country ( active trip on foot) and it was a part of the mobility C3. Before the mobility members of the Lithuanian team created a website to make the organization and implementation of the activities of mobility C3 easier; as a part of it one student created a QR code (coding the programme of the mobility). During the welcome ceremony he explained all the functions of the website. Students were asked to give the feedback of the days on the website. In the afternoon the Slovak coordinator Ms. Eva Ladňáková delivered an interactive lecture made in Quizzes. It was focused on the main features of an Itinerary called „Chronological preparation: Itinerary of a tour. “ In the afternoon Lithuanian students made a presentation on Lithuanian heritage and all the participants attended the walking tour in the city of Silale, visiting a City Museum and a local Library.

The 23<sup>rd</sup> November was an excursion day. The whole group went on a bus tour. Before the tour we all had a possibility to get acquaints with the main information about the places we visited on our website. We visited the Curonian Spit, the golden dunes and other important sites which are a part of UNESCO heritage in Lithuania in the area. Parnidis dune is a unique and the only place in Lithuania. An observation deck at the top of the dune opened up unforgettable views of the endless sand dunes. The participants of mobility C3 visited the unique museum of wooden sculptures in Juodkrante on Witches Hill, which is one of the most visited objects in Neringa. Here they also had the opportunity to see one of the oldest colonies of grey herons and great cormorants in Lithuania and one of the largest in Europe, consisting of about 2000 nests of great cormorants and over 500 grey herons. The panorama of the

Curonian Spit was admired from the highest 67 m high hill of the Curonian Spit - Vecekrugas dune.

The 24<sup>th</sup> November started with a presentation on active and adventure tourism, which was led by a professional guide from KVK, Ms. Erika Čepienė. It was followed by the presentations on active and adventure tourism in each partner country: Italy, Slovakia, Spain, Poland, Turkey and Lithuania. This activity had to help students to improve their communication, IT skills and also to develop their self-confidence. They all were very informative and interesting to follow. So as to cover the topic – Active and adventure tourism - and to be more active, an orienting competition was organized later in the afternoon. A professional coach, Ms. Mikšys Eugenijus, using QR codes prepared the maps and participants. Students and teachers from different partner countries took part in it. The project coordinators took part in a coordinators' meeting and discussed some important issues on how to improve the implementation of the project. A coordinators' meeting with a correspondent of local newspaper „Artojas“ was organized, as well. A discussion on the implementation of the project was really informative, productive and efficient. The coordinators featured the idea that it is great to come back to life again and to implement activities not online, but communicating face to face. All the conclusions are included at the end of this document. In the afternoon students had an interactive workshop, led by Slovakian coordinator Ms. Eva Ladňáková. As a feedback on the previous mobility, the students used information collected and sorted on places to visit – topographical preparation made in Italy. The students working in international groups had to use computers, presentations, QR codes and digital maps. They had to implement all the knowledge they acquired during the Monday's lecture. The final result of the activity was an itinerary of a three-day trip and presentations.

The 25<sup>th</sup> November was the day for getting acquainted with Silale district. The participants had a great opportunity to stay active again as we had a walk on two mounds Medvėgalis, which is the highest mound in Silale district and the most picturesque mound – Mound Padievaitis. Besides we visited a unique church in our district, Girdiske church, famous for its wooden alters. The participants also visited the first museum of antiquities established in Lithuania in Baubliai in 1824 by famous Lithuanian writer Dionizas Poska. During the evening a certification ceremony and an ethnographic performance took place. The event was full of teambuilding activities connected with the Lithuanian traditions. The participants had a unique possibility to see and dance some traditional dances and to listen to Lithuanian songs, as well

as to participate in traditional Lithuanian games. Music, dancing and singing was a way of strengthening the social inclusion among participants.

An excursion, related to one main topic of the project UNESCO heritage , visiting the most important sites, such as Kernave Archaeological Site and Vilnius Historic Centre were organized at the end of the whole week the 26<sup>th</sup> November.

## **4 MINUTES FROM THE COORDINATORS' MEETING**

1. Ms Ladňáková welcomed all the members of the team and started the meeting. In her speech she thanked the Lithuanian coordinator for hospitality and programme prepared.
2. Ms Ladňáková reminded the Italian team about the video that was supposed to be made after the mobility in Italy. She also asked the Italian team for the report from the last mobility to be more formal.
3. There has been a minor miscommunication concerning uploading all of the mobility photos into common Google drive, but all members of the team now understand what and where to upload.
4. Number of followers on social media – Facebook and Instagram profile of the TRIP project is growing, Facebook page has sufficient number of followers and Instagram profile needs to get more. As a result of this, all members of the team will promote TRIP Instagram account on their school profiles and also ask the students to follow the profiles.
5. Number of visitors for the website was adjusted from 2000 per each mobility to 2000 visitors in total.
6. Members of the team discussed number of newspaper articles to be publish until the end of the project, the total number is set to be 25 articles. Discussion about how to store the articles followed.
7. Ms. Ladňáková explained guidelines for an obligatory dissemination tool – a UNESCO guide in all languages of participating countries, the guidelines for the booklets are following: 4 monuments, 4 sentences about each written in mother tongue and translated into English, every country is due to hand out 50 printed booklets. It has to be prepared by hosting country. Italy and Lithuania will prepare it until end of the year.
8. Discussion about lesson plans and their implementing into curriculum after each mobility.
9. Lithuanian coordinator reminded questionnaires prepared by Lithuanian students to be filled after each day of the Lithuanian mobility as a part of a feedback.
10. Before the mobility in Spain certain things have to be prepared by Spanish team e.g. survey of the UNESCO, budget. Possibilities for accommodation were discussed during the meeting.

11. Students attending the mobility in Spain ought to prepare a presentation about Culture and Sightseeing tourism in each of the countries.
12. Rules for the cultural evening during the mobility in Spain were discussed by the team members. Spanish coordinator suggested that each country should prepare traditional music, dance or drama performance. If the performance will be a song, the lyrics can be displayed on the screen.
13. Obligatory social inclusion trip was organized for 25 people by a Polish team.
14. Polish coordinator raised a question if it would be possible to spend 2 nights from the mobility in Poland outside of the families due to the programme – members of the team did not give answer just yet.
15. Last part of the meeting was dedicated to the debate about cooperation with tourist agencies and tourist guides for the students' presentations.
